**USAF ACADEMY ADMISSION ONLINE APPLICATION**

*July 23, 2009*

**A – Online Processing of Application for admission to the USAF Academy**

- 1 – Visit the following academy website: <http://www.usafa.af.mil> If you encounter any problems call 1-800-443-9266 or 719-33-2520
- 2 – On new screen - on the menu on the left click on admissions
- 3 – On new screen - on the menu on the left click on Application.
- 4 – On new screen - you will see “If you are graduating between 2010 and 2015, “CLICK HERE” Click there
- 5 – THE REGISTRATION WILL APPEAR on the Screen – Follow instructions to complete it.

**B – Meet Senators Martinez & Nelson Academy Selection Boards in November this year.**

- 1 – Contact the offices of Senator Martinez and Senator Nelson and request applications to meet their USAF Academy Selection Boards.
- 2 – Contact your Florida District Congressman and request an application to meet his/her Academy Selection Committee.

**NOTE:** You must secure a NOMINATION from a Senator or Congressman to gain admission. You should meet the Boards of the two Senators and the Congressman so that if all three of them nominate you – your chances of admission are greater. Please remember that the local Boards will start meeting in October/November.

**C – After completing the Online application, Contact the USAF Academy by mail**

- 1 – Write a one page Letter to the Academy indicating that in the event of any minor deficiencies, you are willing to enter the USAF Academy Preparatory School.
- 2 – Address the Letter to:

**NOTE:** The Preparatory School is held for cadets experiencing minor deficiencies in math, sciences and other pertinent admissions areas. Over 95% of the cadets that successfully complete the Prep School are admitted to the wing the following year. It is an additional year of study, but well worth it. I suggest you call the Academy at 1-800-333-9266 four days after you have mailed in the letter and inquire about receipt of your request to enter the Prep School. You may inquire about any other subject you may wish to have clarified. They are very helpful to potential candidates.

**VERY IMPORTANT** – Keep a written record with times and dates of all actions you have taken, individuals you have contacted and your responses to request made by the academy. Keep a list of telephone numbers, email addresses and names of all personnel associated with this task.
