ACQUISITION OF MEDAL

CAP Squadron Commanders are invited to submit "requests" in the December-January timeframe. Requests should be emailed to Lynette Cross at: lcross@afa.org

PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

The AFA CAP Medal will be shipped, free of charge, directly to the requesting CAP Squadron Commander. Upon receipt, the CAP Squadron Commander contacts the President of the AFA Chapter located in his/her local geographical area and provides time, date and location wherein presentation of the AFA Medal will take place. The AFA Chapter President and/or his designated representative will be in attendance to make presentation of the AFA CAP Silver Medal to the Most Outstanding CAP Cadet of the Squadron.

PUBLICITY

Widest dissemination of recognition events of this nature is highly encouraged. The presenting AFA Chapter Official and/or the AFA Chapter Aerospace Education Vice President (AEVP) should prepare timely Press Releases for inclusion on Newsletters, Newspapers, Magazines and other media vehicles at local, state, and national AFA and CAP Publicity Centers.
